Who can use LinkedIn?

- Must be at least 16 years old (minimum age)
- Must have only one account (under only your real name)
- Must NOT be restricted from LinkedIn's services

Data



LinkedIn collects data on your account, how you use the site, and how you interact with 3rd party services. Users can adjust how their data is collected and utilized. Users in good standing can delete their data by deleting their profile (except content shared on other users' accounts). Content, including personal data, is subject to the **Privacy Policy**. * ←

Who owns the content?

You own your content. Meanwhile, LinkedIn owns a non-exclusive license to copy, modify, distribute, publish, and process your content - with a few exceptions and limitations, including but not limited to:

- LinkedIn can't include your content in 3rd party advertisements, or publish your content beyond LinkedIn, without your consent
 - LinkedIn also doesn't endorse your content, any services you provide, or any events you attend through the platform
- You can delete your content (such as deleting your account).
 - LinkedIn can terminate your account if you breach the Terms of Service, break the law, or violate the Dos and Don'ts of the **Professional Community Policies**. * ←

- **Be safe:** safe conversations and safe communities
- **Be trustworthy:** true identity and true information
- **Be respectful:** treat all members with civility



- **No** harassment, violence, or exploitation
- **No** false, misleading, or malicious content
- **No** hateful, harmful, or inappropriate behavior. "LinkedIn is not a dating site."
